Official visits of distinguished professors from foreign universities...



Ramon Boges Mendez, Associate professor of community development and planning ,Clark university ,USA carried out a discussion with the department members to seeking possibilities of collaborative research arenas in land use and community planning especially in southern dry zone Sri Lanka through his visit of the department on 27.06.2019. He especially tries to understand the similarities of post colonial development in Puerto Rico and Sri Lanka. Professor Remon is very interesting on the reconstruction of coffee industry in Puerto Rico. In 2018 he actively engaged with one case study in coffee industry resilience with an eye toward giving women a larger role in the supply chain this project was supported by the faculty fund, Clark University. Here Remon and his other research colleague professor. Cynthia Caron interviewed people from all aspects of the coffee-production chain: owners,

producers, farmers, workers, roasters, and shop owners.

Professor **Etienne piguet**, Institute of geography, universite de Neuchatel, of Switzerland visited the department on invitation of department academia on 29.11.2019 and delivered a guest lecture on **"Environmental change and migration: A worldwide challenge**" at department auditorium. It was a fruitful discussion regarding climate resilience and other geographical challenges in post disaster Sri Lanka. Professor Etienne is one of major researchers on climate change and forced migration, population and demographic studies, social demography in Switzerland. In a latest research paper on "*Human migration in the era of climate change*" he tries to review recent literature across various disciplines on the effects of climate change and migration, distinguishing between fast-onset and slow-onset climate events and examining the causes of heterogeneity in migratory responses to climate events.
