

Declaration of Waratenna-Hakkinda in Kandy District as an Environmental Protection Area Thanks To the Efforts of an Activist Group including Dr. H.I.G.C. Kumara

President of Sri Lanka has declared Waratenna-Hakkinda area in the Kandy District as an Environmental Protection Area under Section 24C of the National Environmental Act (NEA), together with the regulations aiming at prohibiting certain activities in this area under Section 24D of the NEA. This order has been published in Gazette Extraordinary No; 2024/06 of 19.06.2017. This declaration came into effect as a result of a six year struggle by a group of activists including Dr. H.I.G.C Kumara & Mr, M.S.M.L.Karunarathne who developed a strategy to get this area protected under the NEA and also to prevent several harmful activities.
