Currently, he is the Dean of the Faculty of Humanities and Social Sciences. Besides, his administrative responsibilities, he contributes in



# Research on Knowledge and perception of the general public towards the COVID-19 vaccine

The Department of Sociology in collaboration with the Ministry of Health and Institute of Research and Development (IRD) conducted a research on Knowledge and perception of the general public towards the COVID-19 vaccine. The survey was conducted in February 2021 with 471 adults who had not taken Covid -19 vaccines.



# Activities of the Sociological Association


